- UNCG undergraduate student pursuing BS in Accounting
- At least 30 hours earned at UNCG
- Senior standing
- Cumulative GPA of at least 3.5
- Accounting GPA of 3.5 based on at least 9 hours of Accounting classes at UNCG
- Grade of "B" or higher in [ACC 318](#)-Intermediate Accounting I

AMP Benefits

- Waives GMAT entrance exam for master's degree
- Up to 6 graduate credit hours count towards BOTH undergraduate and graduate degrees
- Graduate courses fulfill last Accounting elective and one free elective for undergraduate degree
- Accelerates the time it takes to complete the master's degree
