## **Financial Information**

#### Scholarships

- Limited and highly competitive
- Priority is given to those who apply by March 1
- Invited to apply once accepted

#### **Financial Aid**

- Aid eligibility based on enrollment status
- Must complete FAFSA, most admitted students are eligible for Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loans

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited university
- Official transcript from all previous institutions
- Three letters of recommendation
- Personal statement
- Resume
- GMAT/GRE score (optional)
- Online application & \$65 fee (waived after info session)
- TOEFL (or equivalent) for non-native English Speakers

Admission is on a rolling basis



Early application is strongly encouraged
