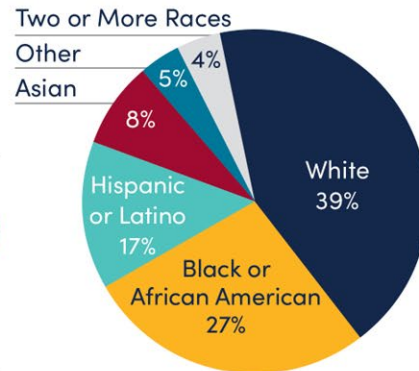

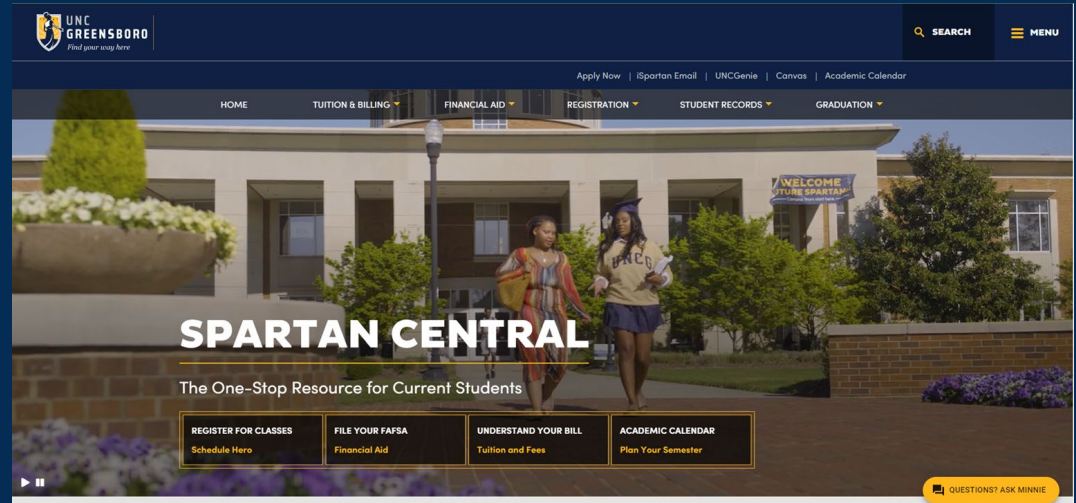

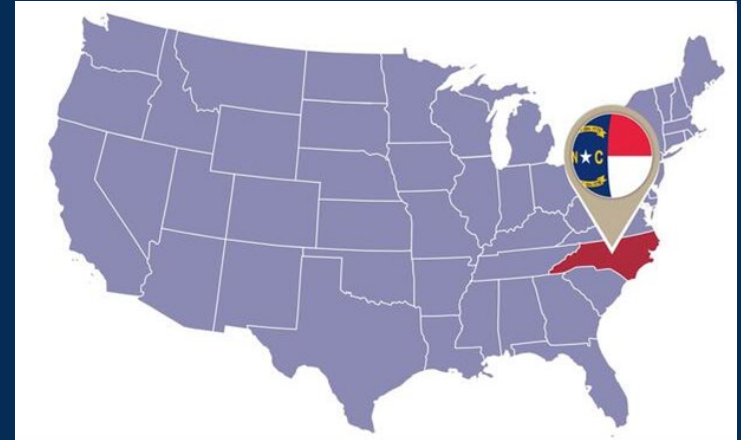

Tuition Bills & Timeline

Your tuition bill will only include tuition and fees **for enrolled courses**.

- Applicants must be admitted, confirm their enrollment, and go through academic advising before they can enroll in courses and receive a tuition bill.
- Applicants must have a tuition bill before their scholarships and financial aid can be applied.

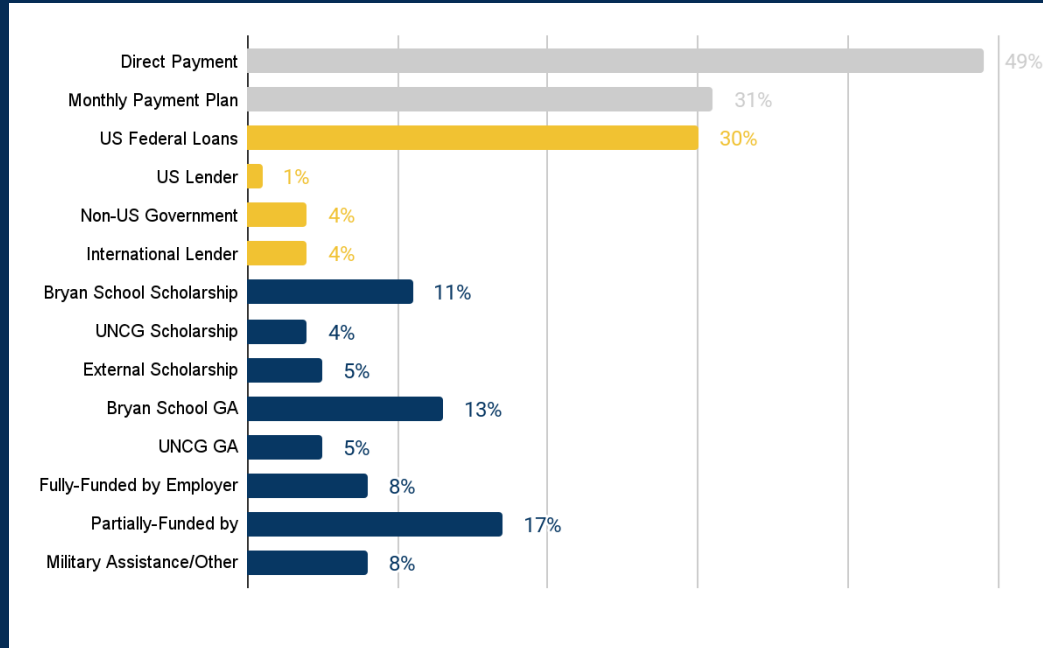

- **Eligibility**

- US Citizens and some others
- Enrolled at least part-time (4.5+ credit hours)
- Enrolled in an approved* graduate program
Program currently pending financial aid approval:
 - Graduate Certificate in Strategic Procurement and Supply Chain Management

- **Process**

- Complete online application (fafsa.gov)
- Once admitted, your record will sync and the financial aid office will reach out to you.

- **Types of Aid**

- **Federal Direct Student Loans:** \$20,500 (annual max), \$138,500 (lifetime max)
- **Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loans**
For students interested in borrowing above limits
No income requirements, but must pass a credit check



NOTE: Graduate students are not eligible for Federal Pell Grant and state need-based grants.

Private Loans

- Does not require FAFSA
- Credit-based loans offered by private lenders to help students finance their degree program.
 - Usually require a good credit history and/or a co-signer
 - Can be more costly than federal education loans

Bryan School Scholarships

- Bryan School scholarship opportunities are **limited** and **highly competitive**
- **All incoming students** are considered for Bryan School scholarships based on their graduate program application.

Spring Priority Application Deadline: October 15
Fall Priority Application Deadline: March 1

Although there are priority application deadlines, all applications (regardless of when they are submitted) will receive Bryan School scholarship and funding consideration. For the best consideration opportunities, we recommend submitting and completing your application as soon after the priority application deadline as possible.

- Scholarship decisions are made **after admissions decisions** and notifications are sent throughout the year
- Scholarships range from \$500 - \$2,500
